

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HEADINGLEY

BY-LAW NO. 7/98

BEING A BY-LAW to prevent subsurface water and surface water
from entering into the municipal low pressure sewage system.

WHEREAS the provisions of **The Municipal Act** provide in part as follows:

General Powers

250(2) Without limiting the generality of Subsection (1), a municipality may for municipal purposes do the following:

- (c) acquire, establish, maintain and operate services, facilities and utilities;

AND WHEREAS the Council has determined that the municipal sewer system is not designed to accommodate subsurface water and surface water;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Headingley enacts as follows:

1. Where buildings are provided with a subsurface drainage system, the system shall be adapted so that the drainage is directed to a sump pit equipped with a pump and discharge to the outside of the building in conformance with the Municipal Building By-Law No. 9/97 prior to connecting to the municipal sewer utility.
2. All building roof downspouts shall be installed in conformance with the Municipal Building By-Law No. 9/97.
3. Lots shall have sufficient grade to provide positive drainage away from the house and Septic Tank.
